

Score Petition Process: For Students

1. After you have completed your self-evaluation section, your LiC will score your work on the scale of 5-10 (5: average → 10: excellent).
2. When your LiC has provided the score and you feel that you deserve more, you can select 'NO' to indicate that you want to write a 'petition'.
3. After selecting 'NO', you are required to write reasons for your petition. Without writing the reasons, your petition cannot be submitted.
4. Your LiC will learn about your petition. When granted, your petitioned score will automatically appear in your transcript.
5. When rejected, you will be provided with reasons by the LiC.
